RAISING UP FORERUNNERS

This generation is arguably the most *distracted* generation to walk the earth. It is precisely against this backdrop of distraction that we are making the call to wholeheartedness and singularity in pursuing God. King David's encounters with the Lord in his youth set him on a collision course with the beauty of the Lord all the days of His life. He was consumed with zeal for the House of God. And in being a man after God's own heart, He fulfilled all the purposes of God in His generation.

"The enemy's greatest tactic is not destruction, it's distraction."

We believe that God's eschatological promise for this generation is to raise shepherds after His own heart (Jer. 3:15): rooted in their identity as sons and daughters, abandoned in their pursuit of His presence, and burning to proclaim a message of preparation for the return of the King.

This internship seeks to *spark* and *strengthen* what the Spirit of the Lord is doing in the nations. It desires to call forth a prophetic Davidic generation who will be unleashed upon local churches, schools and campuses, and the marketplace as sons and daughters who carry the forerunner spirit.

- Opportunities to grow in the prophetic and be effective in communicating the message.

Application fee: RM 50

Internship fee: RM 600

In addition to the registration and internship fees, interns are required to have sufficient funds to provide for food and housing. The following is an estimated breakdown of expected living costs. Actual costs will differ on housing, meals and transport choices:

FOOD

RM 1200 (RM40/day)

**Remember to budget some extra cash for miscellaneous expenses (public transport, etc.)*

HOUSING

RM 750 (RM25/night at YWAM housing—subject to availability)

**All classes and prayer room times will be at PenHOP, 52 Green Hall Road. YWAM Housing is within walking distance of PenHOP.*

While interns are welcome to make their own housing arrangements, they would greatly benefit from living in community.

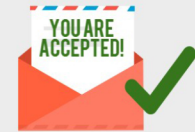
